

I Will: God week 1

The Well Group Questions

This series overviews the four relationship themes as areas of growth: God, You, Community, Others. This week's focus is God. Our objective is for students to know that their relationship with God should be above all else. As a leader, choose questions from each group that best suit your group.

Icebreakers:

1. Would you rather be born with a refrigerator on your back, or have an elephant as a close, personal friend?
2. Ok, this one's for the girls: Edward or Jacob? Guys, if you could blow up the Twilight dude with one piece of heavy artillery, what would you choose?
3. How do you go about showing people what is most important in your life?

What do I think?

1. What does it mean to "put God first in your life?"
2. How can others see that you're living for God?
3. Talk about times when you've gotten really excited about living for God, but you eventually went back to living like you were living. Why do you think that happened?

What does God say?

1. Look up Genesis 6:9 "This is the account of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked with God." What does it mean to be a righteous man?
2. Here's another one: Lookup Phillipians 4:8 "Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things." Do you think about things that will push you towards God or away from Him?
3. Does God want to be second place in your life?

What steps will I take?

1. Do you need to get rid of anything to follow God? Music? Movies? TV? Computer?
2. Will you tell anyone what you're going to do to follow God?
3. Will you rely on your friends in this group to keep you accountable in putting God first? We do groups at The Well to encourage each other towards a relationship with our Creator!

Group Challenge:

This week I'm going to send out a verse and question each day about this. How can we encourage each other to actually look up and read the verses together that I'll send home with you (or text or call or email)?
